To sponsor a child from Fannie Battle:

- 1. Sign up by emailing Caitlin Robbins (caitlinlewisrobbins@gmail.com) by December 1, and she will send you your child's specific wish list and photo.
- 2. Go shopping! Please spend around \$100 total on gifts. Try to buy the items that are truly needed first, such as clothes, winter coats or pajamas. This year we will be providing the children's parents with gift wrapping materials to wrap their own child's gifts so we're asking participants to spend an additional \$10 on gift bags and boxes for your gifts. - 3. Place UNWRAPPED gifts and wrapping supplies in a bag or box with the child's name securely attached.
