

Helpful Scholarship Reminders

Here are a few helpful hints to consider as you complete your Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee application. For details about a specific scholarship, please visit our website, www.cfmt.org, for more details.

Application

- 1. <u>Complete only one scholarship application</u>. The Community Foundation staff will determine if you are eligible for other scholarships based on the information in your application.
- 2. Applications must be completely filled out in order to electronically submit.
- 3. You will be able to **SAVE DRAFT** throughout the application process, should you find that you cannot complete the application at one time.

Applicant Recommendations

- 1. ALL applicants must submit an Academic Recommendation and an Employment/Personal Recommendation.
- 2. Recommendations are attached to your application electronically from your Recommender.
- 3. Family members cannot submit recommendations on your behalf.

Transcripts of Grades

- 1. High school students must submit an official high school transcript and test scores.
- 2. College students must submit an official college transcript.
- 3. High school graduates who have never been enrolled in college must submit a high school transcript.
- 4. Website generated transcripts or faxed transcripts are not official and are therefore unacceptable.
- 5. If allowed, High Schools and Colleges may email official transcripts to grants@cfmt.org.

Student Essay

- 1. The essay will be a significant part of your application, so please give it considerable thought.
- 2. Some scholarships require an additional essay written on specific topics.

General Mistakes to Avoid when Completing a College Application

- 1. Misspelling of words and making grammatical errors.
- 2. Filling out an online application, but then not submitting it.
- 3. Giving incorrect answers due to misreading the instructions.
- 4. Listing extracurricular activities that do not meet the definition.
- 5. Giving your school counselor too little time to meet deadlines.
- 6. Forgetting to check email accounts for responses and messages.
- 7. Asking someone else to fill out the application or write the essay.
